C – Prohibition Bar & Grill - <http://www.prohibition.uk.com/>

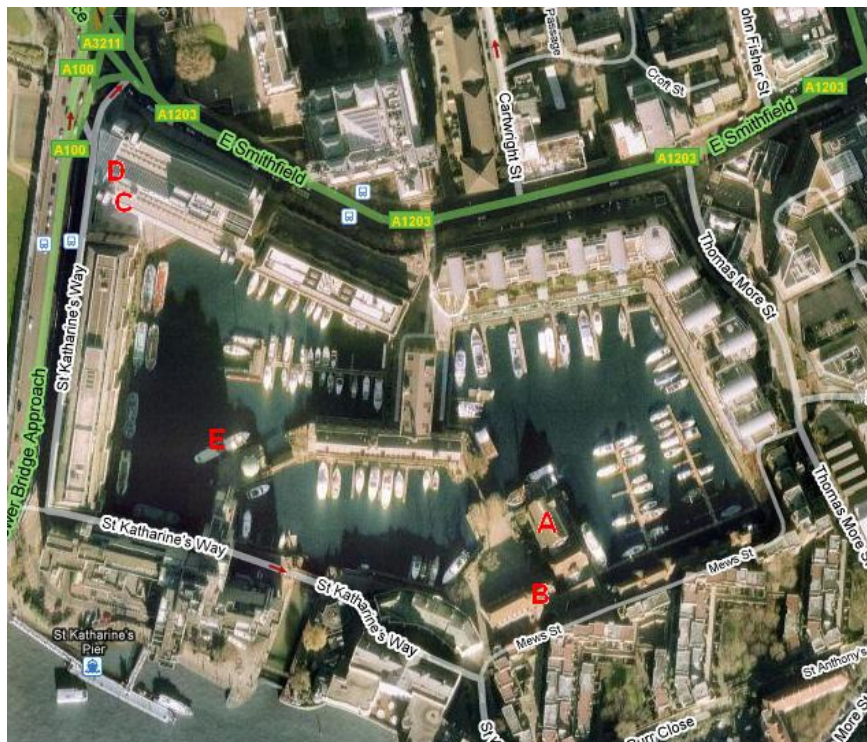
In the corner of the dock, slightly more upmarket option
