The Regatta:

The EAORA Offshore Regatta will consist of three offshore races raced over a four-day period. Competitors have a choice of entering either the RORC East Coast Race or HCC Mercator Race on the Thursday 15th June.

Thursday 15th June RORC East Coast Race approximately 120 NM
 HCC Mercator Race approximately 80 NM
 Saturday 17th June Cannon Ball Trophy approximately 55 NM
 Sunday 18th June Graham Wallis Trophy approximately 50 NM

Competitors can choose to enter the full three race regatta or individual races.

3 Races to count from the series for the Overall Regatta results, the individual EAORA races also count towards EAORA season's points.

For the first race of the series on 15th June competitors may enter either the RORC East Coast Race or the HCC Mercator Race – the Mercator Race has a score weighting of +1 point compared to the East Coast Race in the EAORA Offshore Regatta, i.e. one point will be added to all scores in the Mercator race when included in the Offshore Regatta points total. (HCC Mercator Race is not eligible for the EAORA Overall seasons points the and the RORC East Coast will score normally in EAORA Season Points)
