High Water:

Burnham-on-Crouch 03:00 BST 4.8M Sheerness 15:20 BST 5.5M

Safety:

World Sailing Offshore Special Regulations Category 4 plus Category 3 Safety Harnesses.

Start Line:

A line in a suitable place in the river Crouch as agreed with the Royal Corinthian Yacht Club.

Course:

The course of approximately 50 miles will start in the River Crouch at Burnham-on-Crouch and include the sea areas of the Swin and the Thames Estuary, finishing in the River Medway at Chatham.

Course Notes:

Entrants should make themselves familiar with both the rivers Medway and Crouch navigation systems and be aware of the conditions at all states of the tide.

Finish Line:

A line between the main mast of a committee vessel and a navigation buoy in the River Medway.
